Thoughts on the Scriptures

1Corinthians 13:13 *'And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.'*

In his discourse regarding the 'spirituals' (sometimes referred to as spiritual gifts), Paul mentions three specific attributes of a believer. While some believers are given or portray certain spirituals at different times in their lives, there are three things that are common amongst all believers; Faith, Hope and Love. These eternal attributes are linked as a single verb in 1 Corinthians, however, we can look at each individually to see how they operate and work together.

Firstly Faith. Hebrews 11 tells us that *'Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen'*. Faith however is not based on the unknown. It is not a blind thing in which we use no human intellect. C.H. Spurgeon says that there are three aspects of faith: knowledge, belief, and trust.

Knowledge of the One True God is foundational to our Faith. Faith is not the absence of knowledge but starts with knowing God. Pro 9:10b *'And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.'* An understanding of who God is and who we are in light of Him. That we are but sinners in need of a saviour. This leads us to believe in what God has done for us through Jesus Christ. After knowing about the Gospel, it will draw a man to call upon the name of the Lord, believing and in thus finding salvation.

This all will bring us to trust in God and His promises. George Müller in his Autobiography says 'If anyone desires to live a life of faith and trust in God he must not merely say that he trusts in God but must really do so' To truly trust in God, that He will provide and take care no matter what we face. No longer putting our trust in our wealth or material things, in our own abilities or strength but trusting only in God. As we begin a new year may we make a resolution to walk by Faith. To have knowledge in God, believe in what He has done and then trusting that no matter what 2018 brings He is Faithful and True.
