Thoughts on the Scriptures

1Corinthians 13

What is love? Is it a feeling, something that you can gain one minute and lose the next or is it an action and attitude that we apply to life? Paul in 1 Corinthians chapter 13 describes love. This chapter teaches us what Love looks like. Love is the characteristic that the church is to operate with, and in verse 4 Paul says that love is kind.

Kindness is one of the fruit of the spirit as mentioned in Galatians 5. It is essentially patience in action. The word means to be characterised by tenderness. Helping others with sympathy and consideration. Looking to assist others rather than thinking of our own needs. Love is demonstrated in kindness to one another.

Our desire to show kindness should not just be limited to those who are kind to us but a person characterised by God's love shows kindness no matter how they are treated. [Luke 6:33-35] *"And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive back, what credit is that to you? For even sinners lend to sinners to receive as much back. "But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.*

The kindness that a Christian exhibits is ultimately because God is love and therefore He is kind. God's kindness is shown in His leading sinners to repentance through Christ Jesus.

[Rom 2:4] *Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?*

[Eph 2:7] *that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.*
