Thoughts on the Scripture

Psalm 84:1-12 - PJ Stringfellow

Truly blessed in the man who trusts in God. This psalm describes and illustrates the love for God a believer has and the desire he has to be with Him.

V2 - My soul longs, yes, even faints For the courts of the LORD

The psalmist writes his desire for the Lord is so strong he faints with desire to be with God. His whole heart and flesh cry out. The word for heart is 'לב Lev' it means: heart, mind, will and emotions. The Psalmist is saying ones whole being is crying out for God.

Can we say we long for the Lord, It is usual for us to expect one who is just married to want to spend as much time as possible with their new partner. The company of those that they associated with before is not as appealing as their love. Likewise we should long for Jesus, long to be with Him, in His court. Seeking to know Him more and more and serve Him more and more

V10 - For a day in your courts is better than a thousand. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of wickedness

Even to be a doorkeeper - at the door of the house of God is better that being outside. Do we desire to serve the Lord in our lives here and now and do we long to be in His presence forever?

The early Pentecostals were known as 'second comers' because of their desire for the Lord and belief that He was coming back soon. Likewise we should proclaim Maranatha (O, Come Lord). As the psalm says we are on a pilgrimage, we are sojourning through this land - We live for an eternal kingdom and long for the day of the Lords return.
