Thoughts on the Scripture

Preach the Word - PJ Stringfellow

Reading the news headlines in mid September, one article caught my eye. It was titled 'Niceties never saved lives.'⁽¹⁾ This article discussed the use of words in journalism and how using words such as 'passed away' instead of 'Died', 'Killed' instead of 'murdered', etc. did not accurately tell the story and never allowed the reader to feel the seriousness of the message.

The Christian has a very serious message to give. The Christian knows the imminent danger that is awaiting every soul. A parent would not just sit by and watch a child walk onto a busy road, they would be warning them of the coming danger and doing everything in their power to stop the child. How much more should a Christian warn every person of the wrath that is to come? Many in the 'church' today seem more concerned about making people comfortable and not wanting to offend rather than giving the biblical truth about the judgement to come. The bible's warning is clear. Those who do not have their faith in Jesus will perish.

As Charles H. Spurgeon once said;

"If sinners be damned, at least let them leap to Hell over our dead bodies. And if they perish, let them perish with our arms wrapped about their knees, imploring them to stay. If Hell must be filled, let it be filled in the teeth of our exertions, and let not one go unwarned and unprayed for."

The newspaper article ended with; "Being nice. Being private. Being respectful. That will never save lives." I could not agree more. Lets get out and preach the gospel - That is the power of God unto salvation (Romans 1:16)
