# Thoughts on the Scripture

#### Peace At Christmas - PJ Stringfellow

As we approach the Christmas season we often hear a lot about Peace. 'Peace on Earth' is a phrase often used which comes from the phrase the multitude of heavenly host said to the shepherds. (Luke 2:14 "*Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men*!"). We also see this in the Prophecies about the coming messiah:

Isaiah 9:6 "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, **The Prince of Peace**."

But what does it mean that Jesus is the Prince of Peace? Does it match our view of peace? Jesus' Peace is different to that the world offers. The world offers things for this life; Christ offers things for eternity.

#### The Prince of Peace

So how does Christ bring Peace? We were once enemies against God (Col 1:21). We had turned away from God and broken His law. And because we had disobeyed God we deserved to be punished, the bible says that this penalty is death (Rom 6:23). However Jesus Christ was born, lived the life we ought to live and died the death we deserved to die. In doing so he bore our sins so that who ever believes in him will 'not perish but have eternal life' (John 3:16).

Romans 5:1 "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ"

Jesus Christ paid our debt and so we can be at peace with God. We no longer are enemies but are adopted as children (Rom 8:14-17).

#### **Final Peace**

While there is sin there can never be real peace, there will always be conflict, wars and disasters. Jesus himself told us that those that follow him will face persecution and be hated by man (Matthew 10:34). However we know that one-day Jesus will return as king and reign with peace (Isaiah 11:6-9). May we this Christmas remember the peace the Jesus brings and make every effort to tell those who do not know about peace found in Jesus Christ to have the opportunity to find true peace this Christmas.
