At Capital Bible Church, our statement of faith declares, and we believe and teach the following:

12. The pre-tribulation rapture of the church and the pre-millennial coming again of the Lord Jesus Christ in power and great glory.

The primary Scripture passage on the rapture is [1 Thessalonians 4:13-18](#). It states that all living believers, along with all believers who have died, will meet the Lord Jesus in the air and will be with Him forever. The rapture is God's removing of His people from the earth. A few verses later, in [1 Thessalonians 5:9](#), Paul says, "For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ." The book of Revelation, which deals primarily with the time period of the tribulation, is a prophetic message of how God will pour out His wrath upon the earth during the tribulation. It seems inconsistent for God to promise believers that they will not suffer wrath and then leave them on the earth to suffer through the wrath of the tribulation. The fact that God promises to deliver Christians from wrath shortly after promising to remove His people from the earth seems to link those two events together.

The millennial kingdom is the title given to the 1,000-year reign of Jesus Christ on the earth. The Bible tells us that when Christ returns to the earth He will establish Himself as king in Jerusalem, sitting on the throne of David ([Luke 1:32-33](#)). The unconditional covenants demand a literal, physical return of Christ to establish the kingdom. The Abrahamic Covenant promised Israel a land, a posterity and ruler, and a spiritual blessing ([Genesis 12:1-3](#)). The Palestinian Covenant promised Israel a restoration to the land and occupation of the land ([Deuteronomy 30:1-10](#)). The Davidic Covenant promised Israel a king from David's line who would rule forever—giving the nation rest from all their enemies ([2 Samuel 7:10-13](#)).

The second coming is spoken of in greatest detail in [Revelation 19:11-16](#), "I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war. His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself. He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God.
