Genesis 3:17-19 :”Then to Adam He said, “Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, ‘You shall not eat of it’: “Cursed is the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat of it All the days of your life. Both thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you, And you shall eat the herb of the field. In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread Till you return to the ground, For out of it you were taken; For dust you are, And to dust you shall return.”

Revelation 20:14 :“Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.”

Romans 3:20: “Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.”

Galatians 3:24: “Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.”

Romans 5:20: “Moreover the law entered that the offense might abound. But where sin abounded, grace abounded much more.”

Isaiah 64:6 : “But we are all like an unclean thing, And all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away.”

Man's problem is not simply that he does not know the way.

Man's problem is that he is, by nature, in a fallen condition.

In Adam → fall, condemnation, death

In Christ → grace, righteousness, eternal life

Knowing Grace and Receiving It

Grace-means receiving what we do not deserve. In Adam, what we deserved was death; but in Christ, what we receive is life.

Love- means God did not wait for us to improve ourselves; He acted at the height of our unworthiness.

Forgiveness means that God does not count our sins against us and does not execute their punishment upon us. But in the gospel, forgiveness is not mere “overlooking”; it is grounded in the finished work of Christ.

Knowing Grace and Receiving It

Righteousness or “gift of righteousness.” This is not merely the forgiveness of sin; it is a declaration of being righteous in the presence of God — as though we had never sinned.

Romans 5:17: “For if by the one man’s offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the”

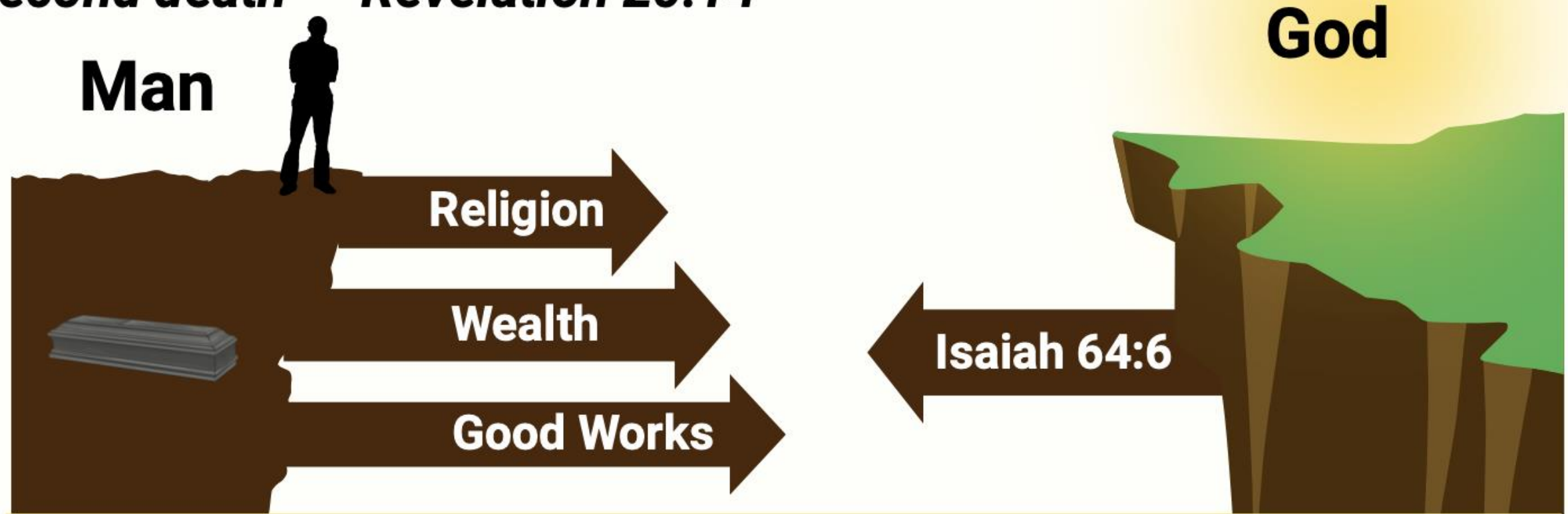

“But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8

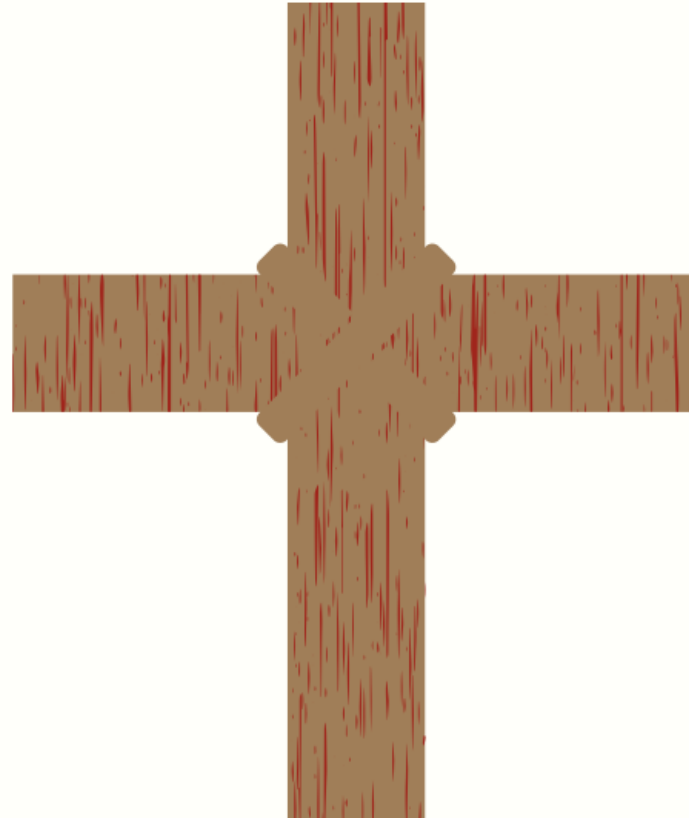
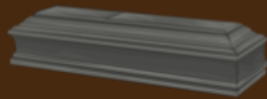

2. Accept Jesus Christ as your saviour.

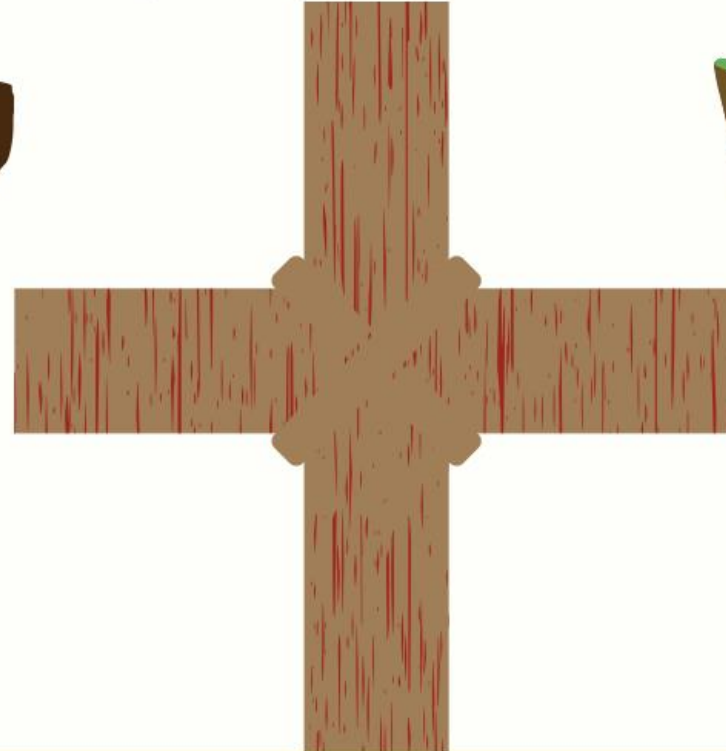
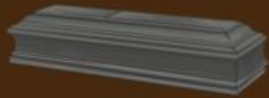
